## **EAST END COUNSELORS ASSOCIATION**

**AWARD:** Four (4) awards of \$2,000

**CRITERIA:** Student must be a graduating senior from an east end high school.

Student must plan to attend a 2 or 4 year post secondary institution.

Student must intend on majoring in one of the “helping fields” (i.e., nursing, school counseling, teaching, or social work).

A student resume/activity list is optional but will be considered.

Student must submit a one-page typed essay (approximately 500 words) answering the following question:

“ What specific activities or roles have you undertaken in your school or community, and how have these experiences shaped your desire to enter a helping field?”

**SELECTION:** **Students** submit your application to your school counselor. Of all received applications from within your building, your counselor will submit one (1) application to the East End Counselors Association Scholarship Committee for review. The East End Counselors Scholarship Committee will select four winners from all nominations.

Notification of winners will be handled through individual districts.

**DEADLINE:** **Completed applications must be received no later than the evening of Wednesday, April 15, 2026.**
